1. CALL TO ORDER

A meeting of the Diversity Committee of the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin, was held on Thursday, August 6, 2026, at City Hall, W63 N645 Washington Avenue, second floor, Council Chambers.

Rev. John Norquist called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

3. STATEMENT OF PUBLIC NOTICE

City Clerk Campolo verified that notice of this meeting was provided to the public by posting in accordance with the Wisconsin Open Meetings Law.

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES
